



### Family Emergency Sheltering in Place Checklist Kit

If you must shelter in place in your home with little notice because of a quickly developing emergency with no time or route to evacuate, plan for these tools and supplies before an emergency occurs. These items can help you to seal your home from toxic gases outside if a chemical exposure disaster develops and/or to make temporary repairs if a natural disaster causes damage.

Some supplies from the Family Emergency Kit are also applicable for Sheltering in Place.

Tools for repairs: ax, shovel, broom, screwdriver, pliers, wire cutter, multitool, hammer, box cutter utility knife, adjustable wrench for turning off gas or water

Portable fire escape ladder for homes or buildings of more than one floor			
Portable butane or charcoal stoves for use only outdoors away from the garage and structures

Garden hose kept near an outside faucet for suppression of small fires or for water for sanitation or cleaning
