With 20 years of adult tenure, Bruce, an Eagle Scout, has served as Scoutmaster, troop committee and district committee member, troop advancement chair, district chair and vice chair, council president and vice president for program, council commissioner, Philmont contingent leader, jamboree chair, Area 4 vice president for finance, Wood Badge course director, regional finance impact committee and finance support group member, and national Scout jamboree subcamp commissioner.

His Scouting recognitions include the Silver Beaver Award, District Award of Merit, Scoutmaster Award of Merit, Scouter's Training Award, District Committee Key, James E. West Fellowship, 1910 Society, and Founders Circle Award. He is a Vigil Honor member of the Order of the Arrow.

Mid-America Council, Omaha, Nebraska

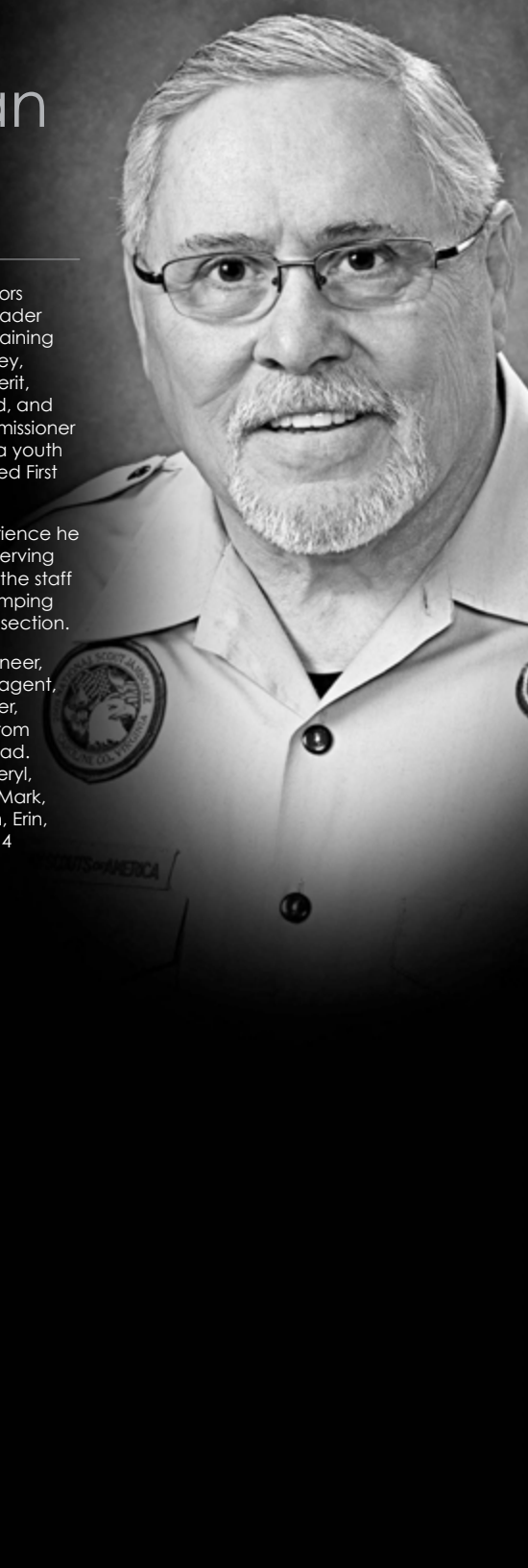
