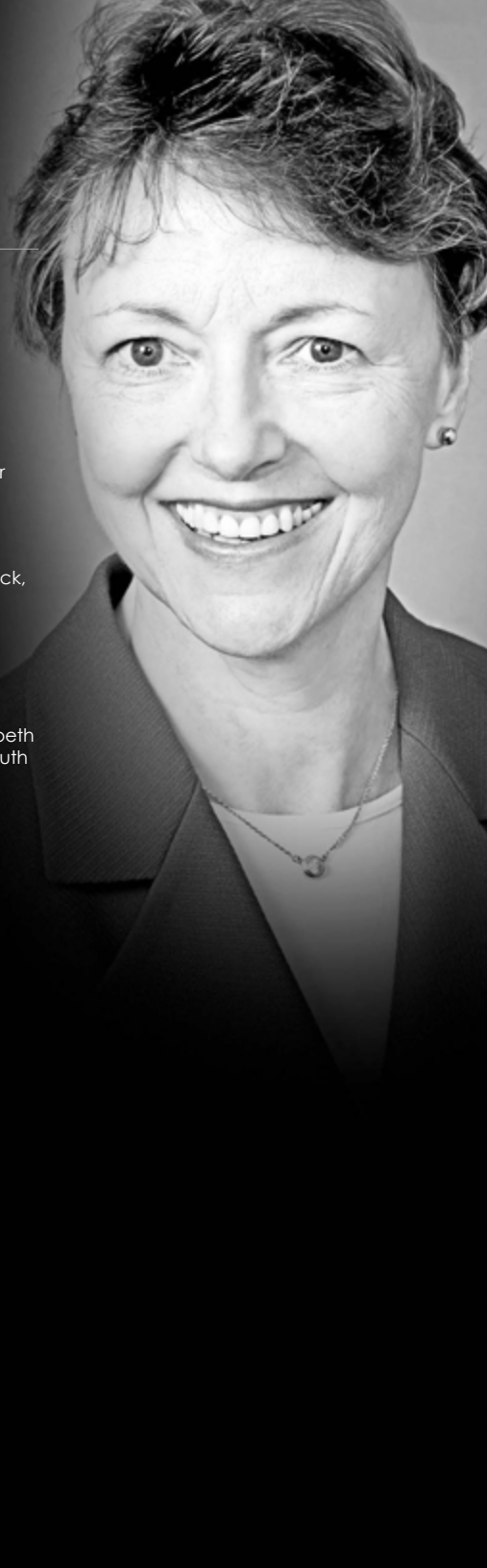

National Capital Area Council, Bethesda, Maryland

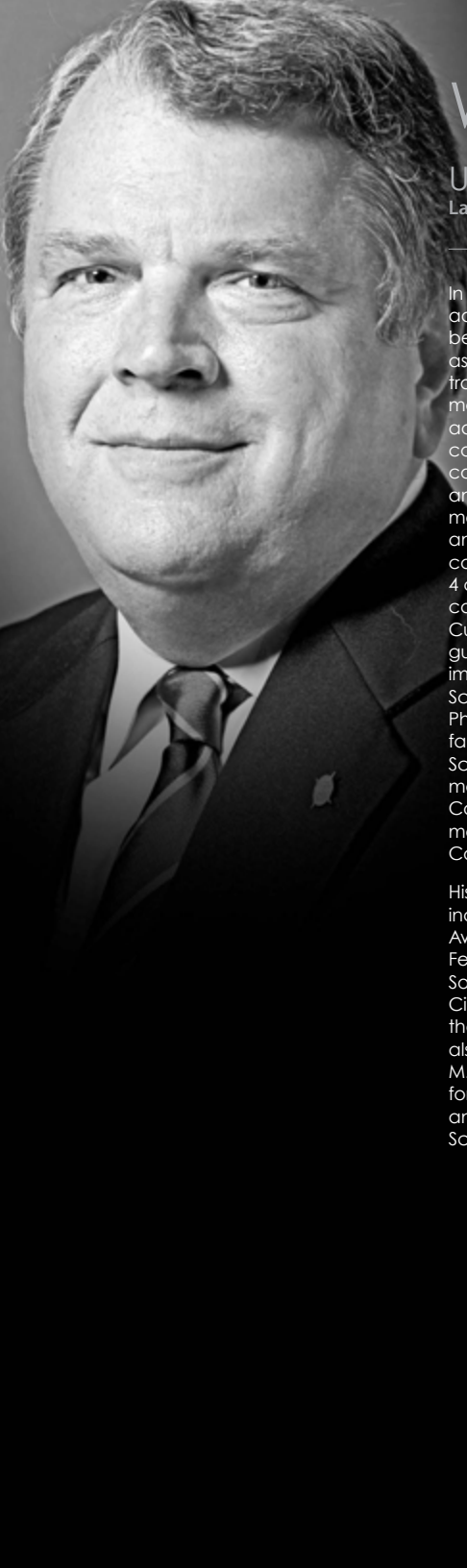
