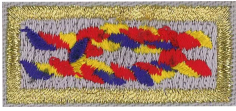


Alumni Award Requirements



All applications for the Alumni Award must be approved by the Scout executive and council alumni committee chair. (If there is no alumni committee chair, the advancement committee chair may approve.) Upon approval, the nomination must be submitted to Scouting Alumni and Friends for recording. The application must be filed with the national office before the applicant may be recognized as a recipient. *Note that BSA alumni include all those positively impacted by the BSA—past and present family members of Scouts, volunteers, Scouters, community leaders, chartered organizations, and the millions of Americans who benefit from Scouting in their communities every day.*

1. Applicants must be currently registered as an adult Scouter in the Boy Scouts of America.
2. Applicant must be a member of the Scouting Alumni and Friends at the Pathfinder level.
3. Applicant must receive the approval of their local council's Scouting Alumni and Friends or Advancement and Recognition Committee chair and Scout executive.

I. Alumni Identification/Promotion *(Complete any three of the five requirements in this section.)*

- _____ 1. Create and distribute communications approved by the local council Scouting Alumni and Friends or Advancement and Recognition Committee staff advisor or designee designed to identify and engage unregistered alumni that have been involved in Scouting.
- _____ 2. Assist in planning and implementation of an alumni activity at the community, district, or council level.
- _____ 3. Make contact with at least five adult alumni not currently registered with the BSA, engage them in a serious discussion about the Scouting program, and help them register online to become a member of Scouting Alumni and Friends.
- _____ 4. Make two presentations to non-Scout groups promoting the BSA, alumni membership, and volunteering.
- _____ 5. Obtain at least two Scout profiles or stories, use them in local council alumni promotion, and forward a copy of the profiles or stories to the Scouting Alumni and Friends office.

II. Alumni Engagement *(Complete each of the requirements in this section. The same alumni may not be used to complete more than one requirement in this section.)*

- _____ 1. Make arrangements for at least two alumni who have not registered with Scouting Alumni and Friends to attend a Scout activity at the community, district, council, regional, or national level.



- _____ 2. Facilitate registering at least two alumni as members of the BSA and members (at any level) of Scouting Alumni and Friends.
- _____ 3. Personally solicit and obtain Friends of Scouting gifts from at least two unregistered alumni.
- _____ 4. Recruit at least two unregistered alumni to volunteer at a community, district, council, regional, or national event.

III. Personal Participation *(Complete each of the requirements in this section.)*

- _____ 1. Serve on or assist in the formation of a council, area, regional, or national Scouting Alumni and Friends committee for at least two years.
- _____ 2. Review and/or update your profile on the online alumni directory (www.scoutingalumni.org).
- _____ 3. Be registered as a member of the National Eagle Scout Association OR identify an Eagle Scout who is not a registered member of NESAs and ask him to register as a member.

IV. Personal Education *(Complete any one of the four requirements in this section.)*

- _____ 1. Attend an alumni session at the BSA National Annual Meeting.
- _____ 2. Attend an alumni course at the Philmont Training Center.
- _____ 3. Attend an alumni course at a national BSA training facility.
- _____ 4. Attend an alumni/NESA seminar in your region.

Recognition Items

Once approved, the national office will provide an 8-by-10-inch laser-printed certificate for presentation by the local council. Alumni Award knots, No. 611866, and Alumni Award lapel pins, No. 612901, may be ordered through the Scout shop. These items should be sold only to those alumni who are on record as having received the award.
