## SAFE SWIM DEFENSE KEY

**Qualified Supervision** All swimming activity must be supervised by a mature and conscientious adult age 21 or older who understands and knowingly accepts responsibility for the well-being and safety of those in their care, and who is trained in and committed to compliance with the eight points of Safe Swim Defense.

**Personal Health Review** Completing the Scouting America Annual Health and Medical Record is required.

**Safe Area** All swimming areas must be carefully inspected and prepared for safety prior to each activity.

**Response Personnel/Lifeguards** Every swimming activity must be closely and continuously monitored by a trained rescue team on the alert for and ready to respond during emergencies.

**Lookout** The lookout continuously monitors the conduct of the swim, identifies any departures from Safe Swim Defense guidelines, alerts rescue personnel as needed, and monitors the weather and environment.

**Ability Groups** All youth and adult participants are designated as swimmers, beginners, or nonswimmers based on swimming ability confirmed by standardized Scouting America swim classification tests.

**Buddy System** Every participant is paired with another. Buddies stay together, monitor each other, and alert the safety team if either needs assistance or is missing.

**Discipline** Rules are effective only when followed. All participants should know, understand, and respect the rules and procedures for safe swimming provided by Safe Swim Defense guidelines.
